EXHIBIT DISPLAY TABLES INCLUDE:

- Listing of Company/Organization name, website and brief description of product/services included in the participant booklet distributed to all attendees
- List of registered attendees provided to representatives upon check-in and a final attendee list post-conference

EXHIBIT HALL INFO AND GUIDELINES

DISPLAY SPACE ASSIGNMENT

Display space is confirmed and assigned in the order payment is received by the event coordinator. To be confirmed, application and payment in full must be received by event coordinator. Display floor plan table layout and assignment list will be distributed to all exhibitors prior to the conference. All table assignments are final.

DISPLAY ACTIVITIES

All exhibit display activities must take place within the denoted Exhibit Hall or Pre-Function space. All exhibit display promotional products must be displayed on assigned table. Promotional activity outside of these spaces is prohibited. Separation of promotional materials, discussion and activities will be monitored and strictly enforced by Governor's Institute staff.

REGISTRATION, PAYMENT & CONFIRMATION

Exhibit Display registration must be completed online. Payment can be made online using a credit card or you may opt to mail a check payment.
