Scholarships to attend the 2019 Addiction Medicine Essentials Conference are being offered by the North Carolina Society of Addiction Medicine (NCSAM) to medical trainees who want to share their work with others who are interested in promoting and advancing the field of addiction medicine. Abstracts related to substance use prevention and/or treatment in the realm of basic science, clinical practice or an interesting case will be reviewed.

Please read before submitting an abstract for a poster presentation.

EVENT DETAILS

The 2019 Addiction Medicine Essentials program offers addiction medicine basics for a range of healthcare professionals working in primary care and behavioral health settings including:

- Core Concepts of Addiction
- Behavioral Pharmacotherapy
- Common Comorbidities
- Clinical Responses to Tobacco, Nicotine and Vaping
- Motivational Interviewing
- Medications for Opioid Use Disorder

Accepted posters will be displayed during the entire conference, starting October 4 at 8am and ending on October 5 at 4pm. Presenter will be required to be at their poster during scheduled breaks to interact and answer questions from conference attendees.

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstracts for poster presentations during the 2019 Addiction Medicine Essentials Conference must be submitted using the online submission process by Tuesday, September 10, 2019.

Applicants will be notified by Monday, September 16, 2019 regarding whether their submission was accepted or declined.

SUBMISSION INFORMATION

- Abstracts from medical, NP or PA students or residents in training with an interest in Addiction Medicine will be reviewed.
- Abstracts must represent the original work of the author(s) listed and referenced appropriately.
- Abstracts must be no longer than 300 words in length, excluding the title.
- By submitting the abstract, you or an alternative author agree to attend the conference if your abstract is accepted.

- If the abstract is selected, 1 scholarship for Addiction Medicine Essentials will be awarded.

POSTER PRESENTATION FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS

- Posters should be a visual illustration that summarizes the author's work by limited text, images, and graphs.
- Posters should include the following components:
 - Background
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
- Authors will be responsible for printing their own presentation.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The NCSAM officers and Essentials Planning Committee will review abstracts based on designated criteria including relevance, timeliness, clarity and potential impact. Abstracts will be evaluated on (but not limited to):

- Relevance to the Essentials audience
- Diversity, quality, and depth of the topic
- Balance and objectiveness of the topic
- Qualifications of the proposed faculty
- Supporting evidence-based data from research to demonstrate results
